THE BEAUTY OF JESUS REVEALED IN THE FEASTS



LAMB BONE

The bone of a lamb represents THE LAMB, Jesus Christ, who was slain for our sin



MATZAH BREAD

Three pieces of unleavened bread represent the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit



MAROR HORSE RADISH

The Maror is a bitter herb, that is eaten to remind the Jews of the bitterness of slavery that their ancestors endured while in Egypt.



CHAROSET APPLE MIXTURE

The charoset symbolizes the bricks and the mortar that were made during those years in slavery, but it also represents the sweetness of God's redemption.



KARPAS CELERY

Karpas is dipped in salt water and eaten. This is done to commemorate their ancestors who shed tears during the years they were slaves in Egypt.



(Optional) This second bitter herb is sometimes added to remind them of the bitterness of the Roman invasions.
